

Our Rules

1. Guides must remain in the company of an adult at all times. No child is to be left alone.
2. Spend time with your son/dad. That's why we're here.
3. Treat every guide as if he were your own, regardless of the tribe.
4. Be particularly careful and attentive around the shoreline.
5. Be prepared for foul weather. Have an inside alternative for your tribal game.

Insurance

The Rich Port YMCA and the Indian Guide program do not carry accident or sickness insurance. Families are expected to cover all health and accident situations through their own health insurance plans.

Black Cloud Rules

1. Dads may not assist with Black Cloud in any way.
2. Black Cloud must be placed at an occupied cabin in full view. Do not hide Black Cloud.
3. Starting and stopping times must be adhered to.
4. The Nation Chief directing the campout will have final say on all Black Cloud disputes.
5. The tribe holding Black Cloud on Saturday night must inform the Nation Chief at the dads meeting.
6. The dads in the tribe that is holding Black Cloud when he stops Sunday morning must sing at breakfast, and will be awarded a Black Cloud ribbon.
